## Meal Plan Options

The Dining Service Staff will be available to assist you in changing your meal plan options to accommodate your needs during the first week of classes each semester.

The following Meal Plan Options are available to you for the 2009-2010 academic year. All Resident Students are automatically enrolled in the 12 plus Meal Plan. Resident students may upgrade their Meal Plan through the first full week of each semester. Each plan also includes the Guest Meal Pass feature.

### 12 MEALS + \$100 IN DINING DOLLARS

Students are given the option of eating any 12 meals served in the Main Dining Room of the John A. Barone Campus Center each week. Price is \$2,270 per semester.

### 14 MEALS + \$50 IN DINING DOLLARS

Students are given the option of eating any 14 meals served in the Main Dining Room of the John A. Barone Campus Center each week. Price is \$2,390 per semester.

### 19 MEALS

Students may eat all 19 meals served in the John A. Barone Campus Center with breakfast, lunch and dinner served Monday through Friday. Brunch and Dinner served Saturday, Sunday and Holidays. Price is \$2,495 per semester.

### 7 MEALS + 600 DINING DOLLARS

*Juniors and Seniors Only living in the residence halls* may choose this option. Any 7 meals served in the Main dining room of John A. Barone Campus Center each week. Price is \$2,270 per semester.

### GUEST MEAL PASSES

An additional feature for this academic year is the guest meal passes that accompany each meal plan. Each semester two guest meals will be added to your meal plan to be used at your convenience to treat a friend to breakfast, lunch or dinner. Simply tell the cashier in the resident dining facility that you have a guest and enjoy the free meal.

### HAVING TROUBLE SELECTING A MEAL PLAN

Try considering your daily routine...

- Do you eat three meals a day?
- Will your class schedule, studying, extracurricular activities or social events interfere with dining?
- Will you miss dinner due to employment or evening classes?

Anticipating the answers to these and similar questions will help you to select a meal plan that best fits your lifestyle.



## A Closer Look at StagBucks Flexibility

How about a burger from the Snack Bar or bring a friend to dinner. The StagBucks program enables you to supplement your meal plan with extra StagBucks purchasing power just for occasions such as these. Additional funds may be added to a StagBucks Account via cash, check or online at [www.stagcardonline.com](http://www.stagcardonline.com) via MC / VISA only. Send a check in the mail to the StagCard Office, visit the StagCard Office, or use the Value Transfer Station located in the Barone Campus Center or the Library to add funds to your account. To make a purchase, just present your card at any on-campus dining facility. You'll never have to worry about not having enough cash on hand to pay for that snack.

**CONVENIENCE:** Dining Dollars and StagBucks may be used to make purchases at The Stag Snack Bar, Jazzman's Cafe, and Barone Campus Center Main Dining Room.

**SECURITY:** If you've lost cash, it's gone. If you lose your StagCard, it will be voided immediately upon notification with the StagCard Office at ext 4009 or online at [www.stagcardonline.com](http://www.stagcardonline.com).

**BUDGETING:** Dining Dollars provides an easier way to budget your food dollars. To assist you in keeping track of the money in your account, a balance displays each time you make a purchase.

- Dining Dollars must be used in the semester purchased. There is no carry-over from semester to semester, and no credit for unused Dining Dollars.

### Campus Dining Policies & Procedures

So that you are sure to get the most from our services, we request that you adhere to the following procedures:

- Please bus your table when you have finished dining.
- Please refrain from taking food, dishes or utensils from the dining area.
- Your StagCard identifies you as a meal contract holder. Meal Plans are non-transferable. Anyone using an ID other than their own will have the ID confiscated, will be fined \$25, and may be subject to additional disciplinary action from the office of the Dean of Students.
- You will not be able to utilize your meal plan without your StagCard. There are no exceptions.

**SPECIAL NOTE...***Dining Dollars, which may be used at any campus dining facility, are NOT carried over from fall to spring in the same academic year. There is no unused dining dollars credit at the conclusion of a semester. Board Meals are good for only one week and only in the Main Dining Room of the John A. Barone Campus Center with no credit at end of the week for unused board meals.*

StagBucks, which may be purchased as "add on dollars" to be used after Dining Dollars are exhausted, are accepted at all campus dining facilities, and are valid until a student's graduation or until a student withdraws from Fairfield. StagBucks are also accepted at the bookstore, library, copying, campus vending, mail room, laundry sites and locations off-campus.
